School Uniform Policy

Uniform plays a vital role in fostering a sense of unity within our school community. We expect all pupils to attend school looking smart and proud to wear their uniform.

Pupils are responsible for looking after their personal belongings, and we ask parents to ensure that all items of clothing and equipment are clearly marked with their child's name.

While branded uniform is not required, all uniform items should match the designated colours even if sourced from alternative outlets.

A selection of pre-loved uniform is available for parents in the school entrance area.

Standard Uniform

- Navy Blue Jumper/Cardigan
- Sky Blue Polo Shirt
- Grey Trousers/Grey Skirt/Grey Culottes/Grey Pinafore
- Navy Blue or Grey Tights / Dark Socks
- Black Flat Shoes (no boots or trainers) with black laces

Summer Options

- Grey Short
- Blue Gingham Dresses
- White Socks and Sandals (permitted in warmer months)

PE Kit

- Royal Blue T-Shirt
- Navy Blue Shorts
- Navy Blue or Black Tracksuit Bottoms or Leggings
- Hoodies (optional for Year 2 and above, for PE only – Reception and Year 1 will wear school jumper)
- Trainers (Reception children will not need these to begin with and staff will inform parents when outdoor PE begins)

Early Years Outdoor Clothing

Children in Little Owls and Hedgehogs should keep the following items at school to enable outdoor access in all weather conditions (however school keeps a selection of outdoor clothing to allow all children to take part):

- Waterproof Trousers
- Wellies

We recommend that children starting in Reception wear jumpers in sizes 26 or 28, as size 24 may be too small for them to manage independently.

Jewellery & Personal Appearance

- A single small stud or small sleeper may be worn in each ear lobe but must be removable for PE/swimming/sports activities. Pupils who wear earrings must be able to remove them independently.
- Facial or alternative body piercings are not permitted.
- Gel nails, acrylic nails, nail varnish (even natural colours), false eyelashes, eyebrow enhancements, or lash extensions are not allowed.
- Hair extensions or clip on hair are not allowed.
- Hair should be tied up or back with a small/appropriate plain coloured hair accessory.

Please note:

Where adjustments are required for individual additional SEND or protected characteristics parents will need to be discussed with the school.
